
HOW TO GET THERE

From Honolulu:

Pass Pearl City, onto H2 Freeway, through Wahiawa, Continue on Kamehameha Highway through Haleiwa. About ½ mile past Waimea Bay, turn right at the traffic light on Pupukea Road across from Sunset Beach Fire Station and adjacent to Foodland Super Market. Follow Pupukea Road for 2.8 miles to Camp Pupukea Road. Camp is at the end of the road on your left.

From Kaneohe:

Stay on Kamehameha Highway past Kaawa, Hauula, Laie and Kahuku. Turn left at the traffic light on Pupukea Road across from the Sunset Beach Fire Station and adjacent to Foodland Super Market. Follow Pupukea Road for 2.8 miles to Camp Pupukea. Camp is at the end of the road on your left.
